All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying, and being in Greenville County, South Carolina shown as Lot Number Eight (8) on Plat Number One (1) entitled survey for C. H. Duck, Estate and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at a nail in cap in White Horse Road Extension and running thence with said road S22 05W 297 feet to a point; thence leaving said road S25 25W 192.5 feet to a point in old road bed; thence continuing S28 27W 237.2 feet to iron pin; thence continuing S19 35E 75 feet to point; thence leaving said old road bed N61 13W 437 feet to a point; thence N21 46E 800.4 feet to an iron pin on Northern Edge of fifty foot easement for road; thence running with the Northern Edge of said easement S59 39E 440 feet to point of beginning.
