All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying, and being in Greenville County, South Carolina shown as Lot Number Nine (9) on Plat Number One (1) entitled survey for C. H. Duck, Estate and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at a nail in cap at White Horse Road Extension and running thence N58 29W 631 feet to an old stone; thence N63 49W 232.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N35 08E 108 feet to an old iron pin; thence N77 57W 294.2 feet to an old iron pin in old gulley; thence running with said old gulley, N32 46E 216.4 feet, N28 28E 110 feet to point; thence leaving old gulley S54 40E 477.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S61 13E 437 feet to a point in old road bed; thence running with said old road bed S10 35E 125 feet to point; thence S1 40E 251.7 feet to the point of beginning.
