RELEASE

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WHEREAS, the undersigned, Joe Carrol, owns a lot with improvements thereon situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, and being known as Lot No. 19 on a plat of the property of R. A. Ford, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book O, at Page 63, which lot is further designated on the Greater Greenville Block Book as T 9.3-1-1, and

WHEREAS, a predecessor in title, Thomas W. Cox, did, on or about April 21, 1966, execute and deliver to the South Carolina Highway Department an easement or right-of-way identified as Project # A552, Docket # 23.552, Tract # 208. This easement or right-of-way provided, among other things, that a 26' x 48' frame dwelling together with a tin-top carport would be moved approximately 80 feet Southeast of its existing location, and

WHEREAS, E. D. Geymont Construction Company of Vale, North Carolina, pursuant to contract with the South Carolina Highway Department, is presently making improvements pursuant to the terms of the easement or right-of-way hereinabove mentioned, and

WHEREAS, the undersigned, Joe Carrol, has requested that in lieu of relocating the frame house and carport hereinabove mentioned, he be paid for any and all damages, if any, resulting from the South Carolina Highway Department exercising its easement or right-of-way hereinabove mentioned.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I, the undersigned, Joe Carrol, do hereby for myself and for my heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, release, relinquish and forever discharge the South Carolina Highway Department and E. D. Geymont Construction Company of Vale, North Carolina, of and from all claims, actions, causes of action, costs, expenses, damages, real or consequential, of whatever kind or nature which I have suffered or may suffer in the future to person or property
