Continued from reverse side:

thence continuing along said Burry property S. 77-38 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 21-21 E. 83.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 0-06 E., 82.05 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Nora Drive; thence along Nora Drive N. 77-54 E. 503.5 feet to the beginning corner.

This being a portion of the same property conveyed to E. C. Burry by deed recorded in Deed Volume 50 at page 339 in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County. Ellison C. Burry died testate October 6, 1943 and under the terms of his will filed in Apartment 469, File 23 in the Probate Court for Greenville County willed all of his property to his widow, Mary Jane Burry. Mary Jane Burry subsequently died testate June 26, 1974 and under the terms of her will filed in Apartment 1342, File 14 in the Probate Court for Greenville County, the Peoples National Bank, now Bankers Trust, have full authority as Trustee to sell all real estate in the Trust.

This conveyance is made subject to any restrictive covenants, building setback lines, easements and rights of way affecting the above described property.

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
