All of that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the northeast side of Bates Street (now Kerns Avenue), near the City of Greenville, and being one-half (3) of lot No. 10 as shown on plat of G. D. Oxner property, made by R. A. Dalton, April 1923, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County of Greenville in Plat Book G at page 42, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeast side of Bates Street (now Kerns Avenue) at the joint front corner of lots Nos. 9 and 10 and running thence with line of lot No. 9, N. 33-54 E. 88.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 55-54 E. 50 feet to an iron pin in line of lot No. 11; thence with line of lot No. 11, S. 33-54 W. 88.6 feet to an iron pin on the northeast side of Bates Street (now Kerns Avenue); thence with the northeast side of Bates Street (now Kerns Avenue), N. 56-06 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
