

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Carolina Avenue, joint front corner of Lots No. 9 and 11 of Block K, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 9, N. 7-13 W. 170 feet to an iron pin on the South side of a 5 foot strip reserved for utilities; thence with the South side of said strip, S. 82-47 W. 70 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots No. 11 and 13; thence with the line of Lot No. 13, S. 7-13 E. 170 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Carolina Avenue; thence with the North side of Carolina Avenue, N. 82-47 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.
