GEORGE W. BRIDWELL, JOSEPH A. BRIDWELL, ROY K. BRIDWELL & CLYDE C. BRIDWELL, Their Heirs and Assigns, Forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land with all improvements thereon situate, lying and being in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being a portion of that tract or lot conveyed to Roy K. Bridwell and Mary Elizabeth Bridwell by W. Clyde Potts and Winifred R. Potts by their deed dated December 4, 1936, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 191, page 62, and being more particularly set forth in a plat made by the Piedmont Engineering Service, and dated November 20, 1950, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "Z", page 161, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Old Poor House Road (now Viewmont Drive), the southwestern corner of the above mentioned tract conveyed to Roy K. Bridwell and Mary Elizabeth Bridwell by the said Potts' deed, and running thence along the northern edge of said road N. 66-38 E. 125.4 feet to a point on the said northern edge of said road; (the iron pins representing the two points just mentioned are set three feet north from said northern edge of said Road); thence N. 19-0 W. 233 feet to an iron pin in the center of a "drive"; thence along the center of said drive S. 84-24 W. 120.7 feet to an iron pin in the center of said "drive"; thence S. 17-20 E. 271.7 feet to the point of beginning.
