the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto PAUL E. GAULT & PAUL E. GAULT, JR., their heirs & assigns forever

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land lying, being and situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown and designated as 2.86 acres, more or less, on a plat entitled "Property of Paul Gault" prepared by Montgomery Surveying Company, dated July, 1975, and being more particularly described in accordance with said plat, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point, said point being the intersection of McCarter Road and unnamed street; running thence S. 51-33 W. 416.44 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 48-11 W. 283.25 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 5-04 W. a total distance of 273.18 feet to a concrete monument; thence N. 52-52 E. 378.98 feet to a nail and cap in the center of Kellett Alley; thence continuing along the center of Kellett Alley N. 52-52 E. 166.02 feet to a nail and cap; thence continuing along the center of an unnamed street S. 39-44 E. 198.18 feet to the point of beginning.
