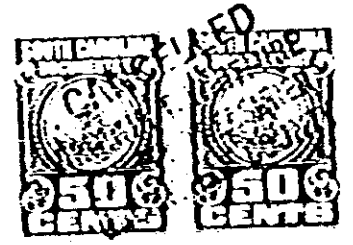

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Northwest corner of the lot now by the grantees, and running thence N. 71-45 W. 71 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 10 E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 71-45 E. 71 feet to an iron pin at corner of other property of the grantors; thence with line of said property, S. 10 W. 50 feet to the point of beginning.

Said premises being the Northern portion of the lot conveyed to the Greenville A.R.F. Church by C. E. Goudelock, et al in September 1946.
