in consideration of TWO THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY AND NO/100 (\$2,970.00) -- Dollars,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

DAVID W. ADSIT AND DEBORAH K. ADSIT, THEIR HEIRS AND ASSIGNS FOREVER:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near Travelers Rest, South Carolina, being shown on plat of "Property of David W. Adsit and Deborah K. Adsit" prepared by W. R. Williams, Jr., Surveyor, dated July 3, 1975, as 2.0 acres, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Northridge Road at the joint front corner of property of Pavluk; thence along Northridge Road, S. 11-41 W., 212.1 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along said Road, S. 8-33 W., 68.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 74-21 W., 334.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 1-03 E., 260.2 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 74-06 E., 385 feet to an iron pin on the western side of Northridge Road, being the point of beginning.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to the grantors by Deed recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 1014 at page 820.

RESTRICTIONS:

1. Dwelling must be set-back a minimum of 35' from edge of Street. (This amounts to 60' from centerline of Street)
2. Only one single family residence allowed on this tract. Minimum house size 1,400 sq. ft. living area.
3. Single wide mobile home not allowed. Double wide allowed on permanent brick or block foundation, 24" min. ground clearance at lowest point required. Minimum double wide trailer size 24' x 55'.
4. Temporary single wide mobile home allowed during construction of house. This mobile home can only be set-up after foundation for permanent house is constructed. A maximum of 1 yr. is allowed for the temporary mobile home.
