the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

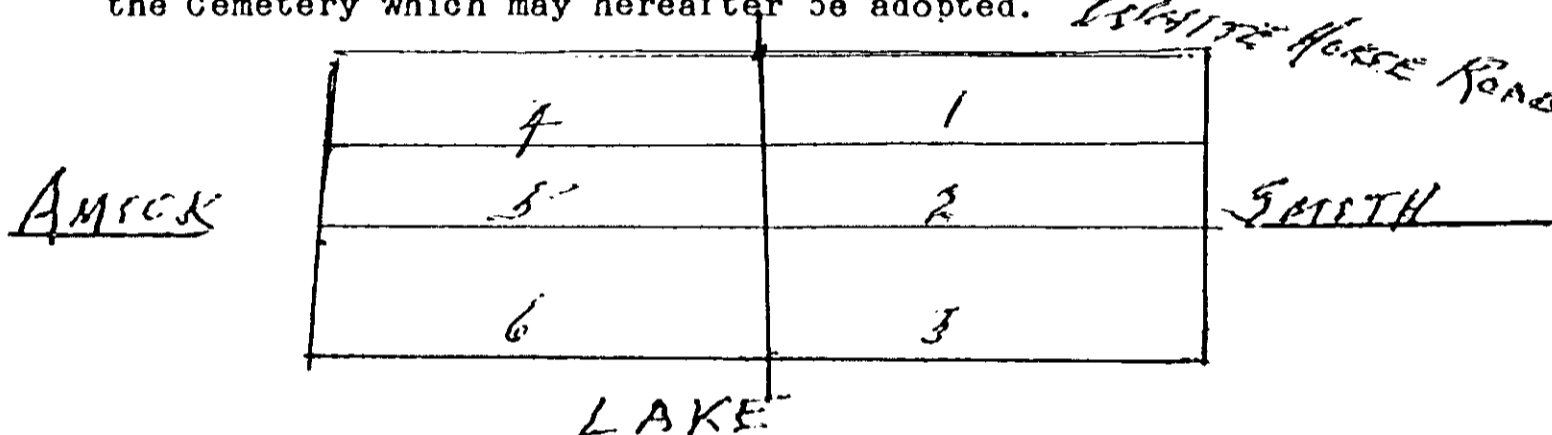
JOHN C. AMICK and THELMA H. AMICK, Their heirs and assigns forever :

One-Half of lot No. 355, Section No. 20 in Graceland Cemetery, Greenville County South Carolina, containing One Hundred square feet, more or less, with spaces for THREE (3) graves, Nos. Four, Five and Six (4, 5, 6)

The remaining 100 square feet of this lot, with grave spaces Nos. One, Two and Three (1, 2, 3) are to remain the property of Homer L. Smith and Claudia H. Smith.

This is the same property which was granted to Homer L. Smith and Claudia H. Smith by deed from Lena Grindstaff Beal and which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 560 at Page 541

It is distinctly understood that said lot is to be used exclusively for the burial of human bodies of the white race, and it is further understood that it is conveyed subject to all the rules and regulations contained in the deed to Lena Grindstaff Beal on May 25, 1933 by the Greenville Cemetery Association and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 80, Page 387, as well as any additions or amendments to the Cemetery which may hereafter be adopted.
