STAY ORDER AND INJUNCTION

The filing of a petition by the debtor under Chapter XI of the Bankruptcy Act operates as a stay of and this court does hereby restrain and enjoin the (1) commencement or the continuation of any court or other proceeding against the debtor, (2) the enforcement of any judgment against debtor, (3) any act or commencement or continuation of any court proceeding to enforce any lien against its property or (4) any proceeding (except a case under Chapter X of the Bankruptcy Act) for the purpose of the rehabilitation of his estate; it is further

ORDERED that all persons whomsoever be restrained and enjoined from the termination, interruption or other interference with utility or telephone services to the debtor-in-possession until further order of this court; provided however the debtor-in-possession shall pay for all utility services rendered after the date of this order in due course of business after receipt of statements rendered in the ordinary course of business.
