KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, James B. Plemmons and Cecilia T. Plemmons,

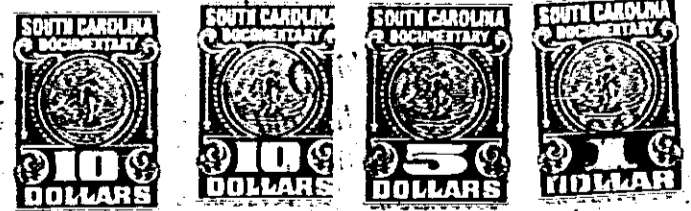

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William E. Shelton and Beverly K. Shelton and their heirs and assigns forever:

All that lot of land located in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Highland Township, on the northwest side of Fews Chapel Road, containing 2.03 acres, more or less, as shown on a survey entitled "Property of James B. Plemmons and Cecilia A. Plemmons" dated October 13, 1967, by Terry T. Dill, Surveyor, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
