

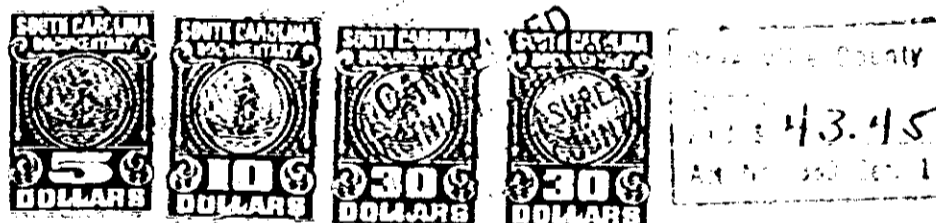

A one-half (1/2) undivided interest in and to All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in both the Counties of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and the County of Laurens, State of South Carolina, said parcel containing 377.43 acres, more or less, as a whole, of which 49 acres, more or less, is located in Laurens County, with the remaining being located in Greenville County. Said 377.43 acres having such boundaries and measurements as are more particularly shown and delineated on that certain plat of J. F. Edwards, R. L. S., dated March 27, 1918, of record in the COO for Greenville County in Plat Book H-P, at page 16, and in the COO for Laurens in Plat Book 27, at page 266; said 377.43 acres being bounded on the North by property, now or formerly, of Wesley Sullivan; on the East by S. C. State Road No. 68 and by West Virginia Pulp and Paper; on the South by the run of Horsehoe Creek, the West Virginia Pulp and Paper Company and Hopkins; on the West by West Virginia Pulp and Paper Company and by Hopkins, the exact boundaries and measurements of same as shown on the above-mentioned plat which is incorporated hereto as fully as if set forth verbatim herein,



together with all and singular the rights, privileges, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said HAROLD BIALOCK, his heirs and assigns, forever.
