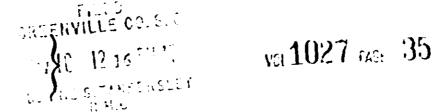

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Northwestern side of Greenacre Road (now known as McAlister Road), in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as the property of Moore as shown on a plat prepared by Carolina Engineering & Surveying Co., dated April 17, 1969, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a.. iron pin at the Northwestern edge of the right of way for Greenacre Road, which iron pin is located N. 31-15 E. 429.1 feet, more or less, from the intersection of Greenacre Road and Hardale Lane and running thence with the line of other property of the Grantee herein N. 57-41 W. 184.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 31-15 E. 65 feet to an iron pin in the line of other property of the Grantee herein; thence with the line of said other property of the Grantee herein S. 58-45 E. 184.3 feet to an iron pin on the Northwestern edge of the right of way for Greenacre Road; thence with the Northwestern edge of the right of way for Greenacre Road S. 31-15 W. 65 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.
