All of our rights, title and interest in and to that tract of land located on the South side of Buncombe Road about two and one-half miles South of Greer, Greenville County, S. C. containing Five and five-hundredths (5.05) acres and shown as Lot 1 on Subdivision for Pet Nona Rogers Estate, December 10, 1975 by W. K. Willis, Engrs. and Surveyors and described more particularly as follows:
