



7) In the event any of the beneficiaries die before ten (10) years from date of this Agreement, then in such event the child or children of the deceased beneficiary shall equally share in the benefits hereunder, including the terms for final distribution of the Trust Corpus. In the event a beneficiary dies without leaving issue, then in such event the remaining survivors of the beneficiaries shall take the share the deceased beneficiary would have taken.

8) At the expiration of the Trust herein, the trustee shall divide the Trust Corpus and accumulated income into as many parts as there are remaining beneficiaries and distribute said Trust Corpus and accumulated income to the beneficiaries in equal amounts.




