

It appears that the plaintiffs and defendants are citizens and residents of the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville. It further appears that the plaintiffs are owners of certain lots in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, deriving their title thereto pursuant to the Last Will and Testament of Ellen S. Huff, as will more fully appear by reference to the Estate file of Ellen S. Huff, in Apartment 137, File 6, of the Probate Records for the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina. The lots owned by the plaintiffs in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, are more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 3, which pin is 7 ft. from the South side of the Sulphur Springs Road and on the edge of a 7 ft. strip reserved for a sidewalk; and running thence with said sidewalk S. 86-36 W. 100 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 5; thence with line of lot No. 5 S. 0-06-E 182.9 ft. to iron pin; thence N. 87-15 E. 100 ft. to iron pin at corner of lot No. 3; and thence with line of lot No. 3 N. 0-06 W. 183.6 ft. to beginning corner.

Lot No. 5

BEGINNING at an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 4, which pin is 7 feet from the South side of the Sulphur Springs road and on the edge of a 7-foot strip reserved for a sidewalk; and running thence with said sidewalk S. 86-36 W. 50 feet to iron pin at corner of Lot No. 6; thence with line of Lot No. 6 S. 0-06 E. 182 feet, more or less, to an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 4; and thence with line of Lot No. 4, N. 0-06 W. 182.9 feet to the beginning corner.
