CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, Helmuth Vits, 17 Stillwood Dr., Greenville, S. C.
Kathryn R. McCormick, 114 Aloha Drive, Greenville, S. C.

two or more of the officers or agents appointed to supervise or manage the affairs of

GERMAN AMERICAN CLUB OF GREENVILLE, S. C.

which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 17th day of
March, A. D. 1976, file with Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That, at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the Greenville News Piedmont, a newspaper published in the County of Greenville, S. C., has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is GERMAN AMERICAN CLUB OF GREENVILLE, S. C.

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is 114 Aloha Drive
Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to provide a meeting place, whereby the culture and habits of people of German descent and German speaking people may be practiced, and the holidays, special seasons and etc. may be celebrated. This would include the Octoberfests, Marzen Parties, Fasching Parties and etc.

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
