

PARCEL THIRD

One certain tract of parcel of land, with all buildings thereon, situate on the easterly side of Main Street in Central Village, Town of Plainfield, Connecticut, and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the Northwesterly corner of said tract on the Easterly side of said Main Street and on the Southwesterly corner of land of Arnold Fenner estate; thence running N. 82 degrees E. 287.4 feet on land of said Fenner estate; thence S. 5 3/4 degrees E. 178.7 feet by land of said Fenner estate; thence S. 82 degrees W. 219.6 feet by land now or formerly of said Fenner estate; thence S. 83 1/2 degrees W. 65.6 feet by land now or formerly of said Fenner estate to said Main Street; thence Northerly along the Easterly line of said Main Street 179.7 feet to the place of beginning, containing 184 square rods of land, more or less. Being the same premises described in a quit-claim deed from Charles Bragg, et als, to Jewett City Savings Bank, dated April 2, 1934 and recorded in Plainfield Land Records, volume 46, page 496-7.
