The above described property is the same conveyed to the grantors by Develcorp, Inc. by deed dated July 6, 1972, recorded in Deed Vol. 948, page 306.

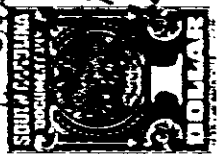
