the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Fay A. Cannon, III and Susan F. Cannon, their heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land, with improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the northern side of Starsdale Circle near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and known and designated as Lot No. 24 of a subdivision known as Starsdale Manor, plat of which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book NN at Page 9 and according to said plat has the following metes and bounds, to-wit: -311-450-1-66 NOTED

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Starsdale Circle at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 24 and 25 and running thence with the joint line of said lots N. 21-25 W., 145 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lots 20 and 21, S. 68-35 W., 100 feet to a concrete monument at the corner of Lot 23; running thence with the line of said lot S. 21-25 E., 145 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Starsdale Circle; thence with the northern side of said street, N. 68-35 E., 100 feet to an iron pin, point of beginning.
