

County of Greenville, its successors and assigns from any claim, demand, damage, judgment, suit or cause of action which may arise between the date of this agreement and the date such drainage ditch is actually constructed as a result of flooding.

FURTHER, Carolina Springs Golf and Country Club, Inc. does agree to remove all loose rock which are now located within the boundaries of the right of way of said road as shown on the recorded plats thereof. In consideration of the above, the County of Greenville does agree that it will forthwith initiate the statutory procedural requirements for the deeding of a public road, particularly, the thirty (30) day advertising period.
