All that certain parcel of land located near the Village of Oneal and north therefrom, (neal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina; and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the Jenkins Road, and running thence S. 49-45 E. 23.99' chains to a stone; thence N. 15-15 E. to a stone in woods; thence N. 46 E. to an iron pin; thence N. 49-45 W. 23.99' chains to an iron pin in the said Jenkins Road; thence S. 44-30 W. 4.63' chains to an iron pin in said road; thence S. 51 W. 4.60' chains to the beginning corner, containing 20.56 acres, more or less, bounded by lands now or formerly owned by William Bonar, H.S.
