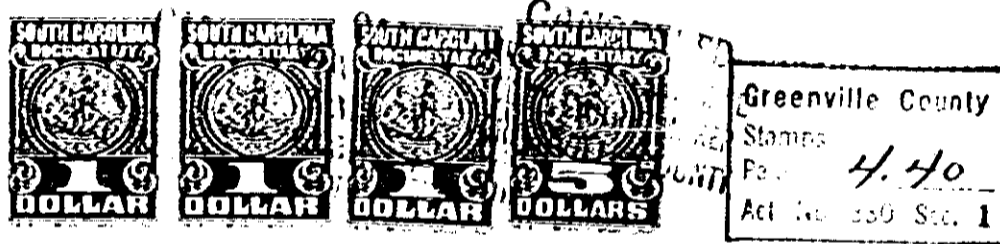
PARCEL NO. 3:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, adjoining Jenkins Estates Subdivision, near Fork Shoals Road, and containing .06 acre, more or less, and being triangular in shape and adjoining on its southeastern edge Lot No. 17 of Jenkins Estates Southwest, Lot 17 being shown on plat recorded in Plat Book 4M, Page 197, and having, according to a plat prepared for Jenks Inc. et al, dated June 1972, by C. O. Riddle, R.L.S., the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin and running thence N. 30-58 E., 102.3 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running S. 63-36 W., 86.2 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running S. 26-24 E., 55.1 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
