

GG. "Unit" shall mean "apartment" or "residence" and shall also mean and comprise the separate numerically identified residences which are designated in Exhibit "B" in this Declaration, excluding, however, all spaces and improvements lying beneath undecorated and/or unfinished inner surfaces of the perimeter walls and floors, and above the undecorated and/or unfinished inner surfaces on the ceiling of each Unit, and further excluding all spaces and improvements lying beneath the undecorated and/or unfinished inner surfaces of all interior bearing walls and/or partitions, and further excluding all pipes, ducts, wires, conduits and other facilities running through any interior wall or partition for the furnishing of utility services, to the residences, common areas, limited common areas and facilities, provided, however, with respect to the walls between the adjacent residence the vertical boundary line of each residence shall be in the center line of such party wall. All of the aforementioned items are included in the definition of General Common Elements. The windows and doors are part of the Unit.
