KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that David H. Roper and Barbara Roper, for and in consideration of the sum of Six thousand and no/100 (\$6,000.00) Dollars, to them in hand paid on behalf of the South Carolina State Highway Department, and in further consideration of an agreement by the South Carolina State Highway Department to annually clean out and maintain the Department's drainage facilities on Bear Drive, Interstate 165 and S. C. Route 20, where Welcome Creek crosses the highway right of way, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has for ^{their} self, ^{their} heirs, executors and assigns, released, acquitted and discharged and by these presents does release, acquit and forever discharge the South Carolina State Highway Department, its agents, employees and servants of and from all actions, causes of actions, claims, damages or demands of whatever were or nature or any manner arisen, arising or to grow out of the reconstruction and maintenance of Highway Department drainage facilities under Bear Drive, Interstate 165 and S. C. Route 20 in Greenville County, South Carolina, or in any way affecting the property of Roper.

This release includes, but is not limited, over all past, present, or prospective damages which might result or be claimed to result from the construction, reconstruction and maintenance of the subject project, including reconstruction of drainage facilities. *

It is further acknowledged that there is no agreement or promise on the part of the Highway Department to do or omit to except that this release does not cover any damages which may arise in the future from the failure of the South Carolina State Highway Department to fulfill its agreement to annually clean out and maintain the Department's drainage facilities as stated above.
