CONTRACT OF SALE

This agreement made and entered into this 15 H day of Monther, 1976, by and between Charles P.

Butler, hereinafter called "Seller", and Connie W. Keason and Barbara E. Keason, hereinafter collectively called "Purchaser".

WITNESSETH:

For and in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The Seller agrees to sell and the Purchaser agrees to purchase the following described property upon the terms and conditions set forth herein:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being situate in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot No. 28, Riverwood Subdivision, according to plat prepared by C.O. BEGINNING on an iron pin on Riverwood Drive, which point is common corner of Lots Nos. 27 and 28, thence along Riverwood Drive S 54-02 E 178.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S 0-53 E 30 feet to an iron pin; thence S 52-15 W 215 feet to an iron pin, common corner of Lots Nos. 28 and 29; thence running along common line of Lots Nos. 28 and 29 N 37-45 W 153.6 feet to an iron pin; thence along common line of Lots Nos. 27 and 28 N 39-29 E 187.8 feet to the point of BEGINNING, and being bounded on the northwest by Lot No. 27; on the northeast by Riverwood Drive; on the southwest by Lot No. 29.

2.
