KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that T. WAYNE CROLLEY AND MARY H. CROLLEY

in consideration of SIX THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$6,500.00) ----- Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto ALVIN R. CHAPPELL AND FAYE J. CHAPPELL, their heirs and assigns;

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land with improvements thereon, lying, being and situated in Fairview Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing 3.28 acres more or less, in accordance with plat made for grantors by J. W. Eaton, R.L.S., dated February 15, 1975, and being more fully described in accordance with said plat, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of a 50 foot new cut street said point being 246 feet from the intersection of said new cut street with Fairview Road and running thence along the center of said new cut street S. 75-20 E. 200 feet to a point; thence turning and running S. 11-27 W. 718.9 feet to an iron pin and passing over an iron pin 25 feet from the center of said new cut street on the edge of said street; thence turning and running N. 73-20 W. 200.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 11-27 E. 711.9 feet to a point in the center of said new cut street being the point of beginning and said call passes over an iron pin on the edge of said new cut street 25 feet from center.

This being a portion of the property conveyed to T. Wayne Crolley and Mary H. Crolley by deed recorded in Deed Book 1004, Page 783, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, by Deed of Leroy Mullins, recorded on August 13, 1974.

This conveyance is made subject to any restrictions, reservations, zoning ordinances or easements that may appear of record on the recorded plat or on the premises.
