This matter came before me for a hearing on November 24, 1976, upon Petition of the Petitioners seeking the closing and abandonment of a certain unnamed alley in Park Place Community in Greenville County, S. C., pursuant to Sections 33-521, et seq., of the 1962 Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended. I find that the Respondent was duly served with copies of the Summons and Petition and filed a Return. That subsequent to the filing of its Return, the Respondent filed an Amended Return in which Respondent prays that Petitioners be granted the relief which they seek subject to any necessary public utility easements. The Respondent was represented at the hearing before me by the Assistant County Attorney, Glen S. Baldwin.

I further find that Petitioners have complied with the requirements of Sections 33-521, et seq., of the 1962 Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended, by causing a notice of intention to file the Petition involved herein to be published in the Greenville-Piedmont, a newspaper published in Greenville County, on April 30, May 7, and May 14, 1976. Petitioners further caused a copy of said notice to be sent by registered mail, return receipt requested, to the only abutting property owners whose property would be affected by the abandonment and closing of the unnamed alley herein involved. I, therefore, find that this Court has jurisdiction of the parties and of
