

furnishings, equipment, and fixtures located in the house on Gin Road in the Town of Piedmont, South Carolina, and any tools, garden supplies, or other equipment which may be located elsewhere on the lot. By deed of even date, she has conveyed to the husband her undivided one-half interest in said house and lot.

3. Each party waives, relinquishes, and releases:

(a) All right and claim in or to the property of the other, specifically including the wife's right of dower in and to the aforesaid property on Gin Road in the Town of Piedmont, South Carolina, it being understood that the consideration for this agreement is full and adequate compensation for the wife's right of dower since the property is mortgaged to the extent of its full value and dower was renounced in favor of the mortgagee.

(b) All right to share in the estate of the other under the laws of succession of this state or any other state wherein either party may hereafter be domiciled or own property; and

(c) The right to serve as executor or administrator of the estate of either party, or to take under the last will and testament of either party, except by will or codicil to a will hereafter made.

4. The wife hereby releases the husband of all duty and obligation to support the wife, and waives her right to such support, for the consideration expressed above and for the further reason that the wife is now and has for many years been fully capable of supporting herself. The wife also agrees that she will support the aforesaid child, Calvin L. Harper (who is not the natural or adopted child of the husband) until he becomes eighteen (18) years of age and will not require the husband to make any contribution to the support of said child.

5. This agreement shall not be construed as a consent to or condonation of an action for divorce brought by either party, nor shall it be a bar to any such action or proceeding hereafter commenced. If either party should hereafter secure a divorce, he or she shall present this agreement to the court for approval in any judgment or decree which may be entered in such action or proceeding.

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
