will work all right, but it appears that it is not feasible to use the roof ventilators. The one shipped is damaged and it will be expensive to remove the other one and patch the roof opening. We have been quoted two units to replace these at \$592.00 each. These units are smaller but have a high C.F.M. rating. They will exchange the air in the warehouse every hour and a half. We are being allowed a \$500.00 credit by the electricians for using an existing 100 amp panel that you are replacing. The two ventilators less the panel credit amount to - - - \$684.00

This added to the above make a total additional charge of - - - \$12,292.00

As per Mr. Jack Sullivan's instructions, we are proceeding with the above items. The monthly rate of \$1400.00 quoted in our reference letter was based on a cost of \$124,000.00 or \$11.29 per \$1,000 cost per month. The above would increase this monthly rate by \$138.78 for a new rate of \$1,538.78.
