- (12) Jan W. Foley (child of Ann Walker Willimon White) ^{Dixon} an undivided one-thirtieth (1/30) interest.

In and to all of the assets of every kind, nature or description now belonging to said trust, i.e. the trust created by William Henry Willimon by his will dated June 15, 1940 and contained in the records of the Probate Court for Greenville County, South Carolina in Apartment 531, File 13.

Without in any manner limiting the nature of such assets by this enumeration this conveyance includes:

All real property belonging to said trust including that situate in Greenville and Greenwood Counties, South Carolina and in Transylvania County, North Carolina, together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances belonging or in any wise appertaining, all tangible and intangible personal property, and all rights and demands whatsoever which may constitute an asset of this trust.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises, chattels, tangible and intangible property, and all assets of every kind, nature and description constituting an asset of said trust unto the grantees and their heirs and assigns forever.
