BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of LaMont Lane at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 53 and 54 and running thence with the common line of said Lots S. 27-37 E. 723.5 feet; thence N. 75-23 E. 150 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 52 and 53; thence with the common line of said Lots N. 28-50 W. 759.0 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of LaMont Lane; thence with LaMont Lane S. 63-46 W. 130 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to Andrew Adams by deed from The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, as Executor and Trustee under Will of E.R. Parker recorded June 18, 1953 in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Deed Book 480, at Page 245. Andrew Adams died intestate on July 7, 1959 leaving the grantors as his sole heirs at law. See Apartment 712, File 8, in the Probate Judge's Office for Greenville County, S.C.. The original estate roll is on file in the Office of the Probate Judge for Pickens County, S.C., and Letters Dismissory were granted on May 13, 1960.

- 1. the Trustee shall hold, manage, invest and reinvest the trust estate and pay over to Raymond H. Norwood the net profits, if any, of the trust estate to Raymond H. Horwood at least annually.
