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TRACT I

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Oneal Township, in the Berry's Mill community, lying on the south side of the road that leads from Berry's Mill to the Barton Chapel Church, being bounded on the north by the said road and other lands now or formerly owned by Paul T. Jones dated February, 1954 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book HH at Page 52 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwestern side of Willow Springs Drive, at the joint front corner of lots nos. 22 and 23 and running thence along the line of lot no. 23, S. 37-54 W. 165.2 feet to an iron pin, rear corner of lot no. 23; thence N. 49-13 W. 53.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 31-47 E. 163.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 52-06 E. 70.9 feet to the point of beginning.

By this deed it is my intent and purpose to transfer all of my interest in properties inherited by me from my father, Rev. Eugene B. Lowery, who died intestate on , 19 , (see file , Apt. , probate records of Greenville County). Tract I was conveyed to Rev. E. B. Lowery by the deed of Paul T. Barton, recorded on December 1, 1956, in Deed Book 566 at Page 301. Tract II was conveyed to Eugene B. Lowery and Velma P. Lowery by deed of William M. Batson and Mary L. Batson, recorded on May 26, 1962, in Deed Book 699 at Page 53.

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
