AN ORDINANCE

MEMORIALIZING THE RESULTS OF A COURT ACTION AND TO REPEAL
OF RECORD ANY ORDINANCES OR OTHER DOCUMENTS WHICH MAY
CONFER ANY INTERESTS IN A TRANSPORTATION FRANCHISE IN GREEN-
VILLE CITY COACH LINES, INC., ITS SUCCESSORS OR ASSIGNS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE,
SOUTH CAROLINA:

SECTION 1. By Resolution 75-35 (P) adopted in formal public meeting
on November 11, 1975, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Greenville,
said Council found Greenville City Coach Lines, Inc. to be in breach of its
public transportation franchise obligations and authorized certain city offi-
cials to institute legal proceedings to confirm such forfeiture or abandonment
by Greenville City Coach Lines, Inc. by a court of law.

SECTION 2. As a result of a court action instituted November 13, 1975
against Greenville City Coach Lines, Inc. by the City of Greenville in Common
Pleas Court for Greenville County, Case number 75-CP-23-1425, praying that the
Court adjudicate any interests of the parties and confirm that Greenville City
Coach lines had unilaterally forfeited or abandoned its franchise without the
consent of the City, a jury verdict so finding was had on October 14, 1976, in
favor of the City of Greenville.

SECTION 3. Greenville City Coach Lines, Inc. held any such interests
in the public transportation franchise as a successor-in-interest to a franchise
ordinance or amendments of June 3, 1899, ratified June 23, 1899 and July 14,
1899, from the City of Greenville to George M. Bunting and Associates, and sub-
sequently assigned to various holders until received by Greenville City Coach
Lines, Inc. on June 7, 1955. Said documents are in part of record in the RMC
Office for Greenville County at the Greenville County Court House in Deed Books
HHH at Page 8, Book DDD at Page 652, and Book 32 at Page 1.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance memorializes the actions of City Council by
Resolution of November 11, 1975 and the court verdict of October 14, 1976, pub-
lishes same in the permanent records of the City of Greenville, and repeals any
ordinances or other documents granting any public transportation franchise
rights or interests except as any are now exercised by the Greenville Transit
Authority pursuant to Act 417 (1973) approved July 9, 1973.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective upon date of passage,
designated as Ordinance No. 77-3. This Ordinance supercedes any inconsistent
ordinances.
