ALL that lot of land situate on the westerly side of North Spring Street in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as a tract containing 8,193 sq. ft. on a plat of the property of Fidelity Federal Savings and Loan Association dated March 21, 1977, prepared by W. R. Williams, Jr., Engineer, recorded in Plat Book 5-7 at page 84 in the RMC Office for Greenville County, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
