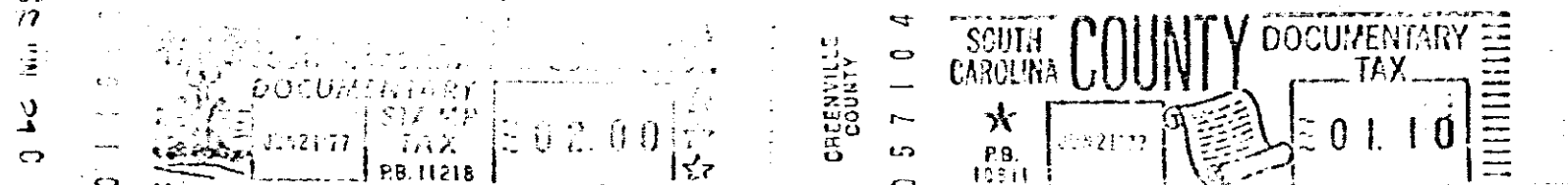
in consideration of Eight Hundred and 00/100 (\$800.00)-----Dollars,
