

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of South Valley Lane at the joint front corner of Lots 55 and 56, and running thence with the line of Lot 55, S. 3-11 E., 225 feet to an iron pin on the North side of a 36-foot alley; thence with the North side of said alley, N. 86-49 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 57, N. 3-11 W., 225 feet to an iron pin on the South side of South Valley Lane; thence with South Valley Lane, S. 86-49 W., 100 feet to the point of beginning.
