the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto PEARLIE G. MOORE, her heirs and assigns forever:

ALL OUR UNDIVIDED RIGHT, TITLE, INTEREST AND ESTATE IN AND TO THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTY:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, Greenville County, and being shown as 1.0 acre on survey for Pearlle G. Moore, prepared by Carolina Surveying Co., dated 30 May 1977, to be recorded in Plat Book 65, Page 72, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin, which iron pin is 490 feet, more or less, northwest of Davenport Road in the centerline of a 50 foot easement as shown on said plat, and running thence S. 65-0 W., 72.5 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running N. 25-0 W., 290 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running N. 65-0 E., 150 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running S. 25-0 E., 290 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running S. 65-0 W., 77.5 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

This being a portion of the property conveyed to Edwin Griffin and Sarah D. Griffin by deed of Estella Goldsmith, recorded July 22, 1958, in Deed Book 602, Page 328, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County. Thereafter, the said Sarah D. Griffin died intestate in approximately 1962 and no estate has been filed in the Probate Court for Greenville County. She was survived by her husband, Edwin Griffin, and five children, Pearlle G. Moore, Dorothy G. Seawright, Joe L. Griffin, John D. Griffin, and Carlton E. Griffin.
