the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto James M. McJunkin, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All our right, title and interest in and to that certain tract of land containing 50 acres, more or less, situate, lying and being in said County and State, and situate on the waters of the South fork of Saluda River. BEGINNING on a white oak corner on the ridge below the Ball rock; thence South along Mrs. Ropers line to a Hickory corner; thence East to Clybon Mill Shoal; thence East along Joseph Hardins line to a pine corner on the Hog Branch including all lands above the Clifts; thence up the Hog Branch to Joseph McJunkin's line, said land containing 50 acres, more or less.

This being an undivided interest in the same property conveyed by Joseph Hardin by deed dated June 26, 1869, to our grandfather, Joseph McJunkin, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., on July 28, 1869, in Deed Book BB at Pages 413 and 414.

This conveyance is made subject to any and all existing reservations, easements, rights of way, zoning ordinances and restrictions or protective covenants that may appear of record, on the recorded plat or on the premises.

together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s), and the grantee's(s') heirs, successors and assigns, forever. And, the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') heirs, successors, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto the grantee(s) and the grantee's(s') heirs, successors and assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') heirs, successors and assigns and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
