IN THE COUNTY of Greenville, State of South Carolina: On the Southern side of Sixth Street, being shown and designated as Lot 79 on plat of Judson Mills Village, Section 4, prepared by Dalton E. Neves, January, 1941, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at Pages 75 and 76.
