(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. CARROLL HUFF and OLLIE A. HUFF, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, located on the South side of road to Tigerville, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of said road that leads from Travelers Rest to Tigerville on line of land now or formerly of E. Hart and running thence along said road S. 88 E., 150 feet to iron pin on said road; thence S. 10-30 E., 297.4 feet to iron pin; thence N. 88 W., 150 feet to iron pin; thence N. 10-30 W., 297.4 feet to the beginning corner, bounded on the east and south by lands formerly of J.
