

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED to be present at such time and to present such evidence of damages and right to compensation as you see fit. Any benefits to be derived by reason of the existence of the sewer line shall be taken into consideration in determining the amount of compensation to be awarded, if any.

The property across which the right of way is required is that property of the Landowner acquired by deed recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Deed Book 133 at Page 561 and being further designated on the Greenville County Tax Map Records as Sheet 545.1, Block 1, Lot 26. The right of way required will be fifty (50) feet only during construction, but after construction shall be reduced to twenty-five (25) feet, extending twelve and one-half (12 1/2) feet on each side of the center line which has been or will be staked on the property.
