This is the identical property which was formerly owned by Elizabeth Brown who died intestate on January 23, 1976, and who died leaving twenty-two (22) nieces and nephews, the children of six deceased brothers and sisters. The Grantor herein is a grandniece of the said Elizabeth Brown by virtue of being one of the six children of Margaret Rush a niece of the said Elizabeth Brown. The said Margaret Rush died testate as will appear in the records of the Probate Court of Anderson County subsequent to the death of Elizabeth Brown. Under the provisions of the Will of Margaret Rush her estate was to be divided equally among her children and in the event any of her children predeceased her, the children of said predeceased child were to take said predeceased children's share. The children of Margaret Rush living on her death are as follows: The grantor herein, and additionally, Frances Jeffords, Elizabeth Smith, Zessie Webb, William C. Rush.
