ALL MY RIGHT, TITLE, AND INTEREST, THE SAME BEING AN UNDIVIDED ONE-HALF (1/2) INTEREST IN AND TO All those certain pieces, parcels, or lots of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the southeasterly side of Brookview Circle, being shown and designated as Lots Nos. 73 and 74, on plat of Shannon Terrace, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "G", at Page 261, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:  
BEGINNING at a point on the southeasterly side of Brookview Circle, joint corner of Lots Nos. 72 and 73 and running thence with the joint lines of said lots, S. 54-35 E. 209.5 feet; thence in a northerly direction, N. 28-54 E. along the rear of Lots Nos. 73 and 74, 127.9 feet to the rear joint corner of Lots Nos. 74 and 75; thence with the joint lines of Lots Nos. 74 and 75, N. 47-17 W. 186.3 feet to a point on Brookview Circle; thence with Brookview Circle, S. 39-30 W. 150 feet to the point of BEGINNING.
