South Carolina State Highway Department, its Successors and Assigns

All that certain piece, parcel, or strip of land containing approx-
imately 0.06 acre, lying and being on the eastern side of Route I-85 at
its intersection with S. C. Highway 146, in or near the City of Greenville,
County of Greenville, State of South Carolina. Said property having the
following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of S. C.
Highway 146, thence S 52°-19'E for 166.5 feet, more
or less, to an iron pin; thence S 44°-23'E for 88.0 feet, more
or less, to an iron pin; thence N 52°-15'W for 265.3 feet,
