

NOW, Therefore, Know all men by these Presents, that I, FRANK P. McGOWAN, JR., as Master, in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and no/100-----(\$500.00)---- Dollars, to me paid by the said Administrator of Veterans' Affairs, an Officer of the United States of America, whose principal office and post office address is Veterans' Administration, Washington 25, D. C., and his successors in such office, as such and assigns the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Administrator of Veterans' Affairs, an Officer of the United States of America, whose principal office and post office address is Veterans' Administration, Washington 25, D. C., and his successors in such office, as such and assigns:
