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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Irene Hammond

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Gary Joe Hammond, his heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that piece, parcel of land lying situate and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of Brushy Creek Road, and being the joint corner now or formerly with Wallace Knight and running thence to the center of said road S. 83-28 E. 300 feet to a point in the center of said road; thence continuing with the road S. 78-28 E. 227 feet to a nail and stopper in the center of the road (iron pin on the eastern bank of the road and on the next line); thence N. 14-30 E. 229 feet to an iron pin on the line now or (formerly) of Boling; thence with the Boling line N.75-30 W. 524 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of the Wallace Knight lot; thence with the Wallace Knight line S. 14-30 W. 283 feet to the beginning corner, and containing three acres, more or less.
