CREDITORS' PETITION FOR BANKRUPTCY

1. Petitioners, Harpeth National Bank, Public Square, Franklin, Tennessee; The Tappan Company, 206 Woodford Avenue, Elyria, Ohio; and Airtemp Corporation, Woodbridge Avenue, Edison, New Jersey, are creditors of Jack L. Walker, of Route 5, Wilson Pike, Brentwood, Williamson County, Tennessee, having provable claims against him, not contingent as to liability, amounting in the aggregate, in excess of the value of securities held by them, to \$500.00 or over. The nature and amount of petitioners' claims are as follows:

- a. Harpeth National Bank is owed \$163,538.14 for money lent to Jack L. Walker Construction Services, Inc. This indebtedness is past due and unpaid and its prompt payment has been unconditionally guaranteed by the alleged bankrupt. (The bank has set off against this indebtedness the sum of approximately \$5,200.00.)
- b. The Tappan Company is owed \$13,203.25 for equipment sold to Jack L. Walker Construction Services, Inc. This indebtedness is past due and unpaid and its prompt payment has been unconditionally guaranteed by the alleged bankrupt.
